- (B) EACH PERSON APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AS A SPECIAL POLICEMAN MAY:
- (1) FILE A STATEMENT OF CHARGES IN THE DISTRICT COURT AGAINST A DEFENDANT-WHO HAS NOT BEEN ARRESTED FOR THAT OFFENSE UPON WRITTEN APPLICATION CONTAINING AN AFFIDAVIT SHOWING PROBABLE CAUSE THAT THE DEFENDANT COMMITTED THE OFFENSE CHARGED; AND

- (1) When a check-or-other instrument has been dishonored by nonacceptance or nonpayment and has not been paid within 10 days, the holder to whom the check or other instrument was issued-or-negotiated-may-send-a-notice of dishonor to the maker or drawer as provided under this section.
- (2) If a check or other instrument has not been paid within 30 days after the holder has sent a notice of dishonor to the maker or drawer, the maker or drawer of a check or other instrument that has been dishonored may be liable for:
  - (a) The amount of the check or instrument;
  - (b) A collection fee of up to \$25; and
- (e) An amount up to 2 times the amount of the check, but not more than \$1.000.
- (3) (a) (i) The holder of a check or other instrument that has been dishonored may seek the damages provided under this section in any District Court of the State 30 days after a notice of dishonor has been sent by mail to the last known address of the maker or drawer.
- (ii) The holder shall obtain a certificate of mailing from the U.S. Postal Service for each notice sent by the holder under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.
- (b) A notice of dishonor sent by a holder under this section to a maker or drawer of a dishonored check or other instrument shall substantially comply with the form prescribed in § 3-513 of this subtitle.
