

## Article - Business Occupations and Professions

13-501.

(a) A person shall be licensed as a private detective agency before the person may engage in the business of providing security guards for hire.

(b) (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a licensed private detective agency may provide an individual for hire as a security guard only if the individual is certified by the Superintendent as a private detective or as a security guard.

(2) A licensed private detective agency may provide an uncertified individual for hire as a security guard if:

(i) 1. the private detective agency has submitted to the Superintendent the application of the individual for certification as a security guard, fingerprint cards, and records fee as required under § 13-502(b) of this subtitle; ~~and~~

~~(ii)~~ 2. the Superintendent has not disapproved the application [.]

~~(iii)~~ (ii) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS OBTAINED AND CURRENTLY POSSESSES CERTIFICATION BY THE MARYLAND POLICE AND CORRECTIONS TRAINING COMMISSION AS A POLICE OFFICER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.
