SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Labor and Employment

## SUBTITLE 16. SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

8-1601.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACTIVITIES" MEANS ACTIVITIES APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY IN WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A BUSINESS AND BECOMING SELF-EMPLOYED. SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACTIVITIES MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, ENTREPRENEURIAL TRAINING, BUSINESS COUNSELING, AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.
- (C) "SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ALLOWANCE" MEANS AN ALLOWANCE PAYABLE, IN LIEU OF REGULAR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS, FROM THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE TRUST FUND TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (D) "SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM UNDER WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS DESCRIBED IN § 8-1604 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE IN LIEU OF REGULAR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THAT INDIVIDUAL IN ESTABLISHING A BUSINESS AND BECOMING SELF-EMPLOYED.
- (E) "REGULAR BENEFITS" MEANS BENEFITS PAYABLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS TITLE, INCLUDING BENEFITS PAYABLE TO FEDERAL CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES AND TO EX-SERVICEMEMBERS AS DEFINED IN 5 U.S.C. SECTION 8521(A) WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR EX-SERVICEMEMBERS UNDER 5 U.S.C. SECTION 8521.
