- (F) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION IS NOT REQUIRED TO PROVIDE HOSPITALIZATION, LABORATORY, OR PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES AS PART OF ITS BENEFIT PACKAGE MAY PROVIDE A LIMITED SET OF HEALTH BENEFITS IF:
- (1) THE BENEFIT PACKAGE THE LIMITED SET OF HEALTH BENEFITS IS FOR SUBSCRIBERS OR MEMBERS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN A COUNTY PROGRAM TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS; AND
- (2) THE HOSPITALIZATION, LABORATORY, OR PHARMACEUTICAL SERVICES ARE BEING DONATED TO THE SUBSCRIBERS OR MEMBERS BY A PROVIDER

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
