- (1) STATES STATE THAT VESSELS LEFT AT THE MARINA WITHOUT PERMISSION FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS ARE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL AT THE VESSEL OWNER'S EXPENSE;
- (2) STATES STATE THE LOCATION TO WHICH THE VESSEL WILL BE REMOVED;
- (3) STATES STATE THE MAXIMUM-AMOUNT THAT THE VESSEL OWNER OF THE VESSEL MAY BE CHARGED FOR THE REMOVAL WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REMOVAL AND STORAGE OF THE VESSEL; AND
- (4) PROVIDES PROVIDE THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A PERSON WHO CAN BE CONTACTED TO ARRANGE FOR THE RECLAIMING OF THE VESSEL BY ITS OWNER OR THE OWNER'S AGENT.
- (B) A VESSEL MAY NOT BE REMOVED FROM A MARINA TO A LOCATION THAT IS MORE THAN 30 MILES FROM THE MARINA.
- (C) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A MARINA, OR THE AGENT OF THE OWNER OR OPERATOR, ON FINDING A VESSEL LEFT AT THE MARINA WITHOUT PERMISSION, SHALL MAKE A REASONABLE ATTEMPT TO NOTIFY THE VESSEL OWNER OR THE VESSEL OWNER'S AGENT OF THE INTENDED REMOVAL OF THE VESSEL BEFORE THE VESSEL MAY BE REMOVED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (C) (D) A PERSON WHO UNDERTAKES THE REMOVAL OF A REMOVES THE VESSEL FROM A MARINA:
- (1) SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN 2 HOURS VESSEL OWNER OR THE VESSEL OWNER'S AGENT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE TIME AFTER REMOVING THE VESSEL FROM THE MARINA, AND SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- (I) A DESCRIPTION OF THE VESSEL INCLUDING THE VESSEL'S CERTIFICATE OF BOAT NUMBER;
 - (II) THE DATE AND TIME THE VESSEL WAS REMOVED;
 - (III) THE REASON THE VESSEL WAS REMOVED; AND
- (IV) THE LOCATIONS FROM WHICH AND TO WHICH THE VESSEL WAS REMOVED;
- (2) BEFORE REMOVING THE VESSEL, SHALL HAVE AUTHORIZATION OF THE MARINA OWNER: AND
- (3) MAY NOT PAY ANY REMUNERATION TO THE OWNER OF THE MARINA.
- (D) IF A VESSEL IS REMOVED FROM A MARINA, THE PERSON IN POSSESSION OF THE VESSEL SHALL:
