(b) The Board has 11 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The members of the Board serve for terms of 4 years each and are as follows:

(c) The Commission consists of nine members as follows:

(1) Six members shall be appointed by the Governor as follows:

(i) [Two] ONE shall be [representatives] A REPRESENTATIVE of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services[, including at least one representative of the Maryland State Police Bureau of Drug Enforcement];

(II) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BUREAU OF DRUG ENFORCEMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE;

[(ii)](III) One shall be a representative of a local police department;

[(iii)] (IV) Two shall be representatives of the general public; and

[(iv)] (V) One shall be a representative of the State's Attorney's Association.
