(2) Which is a felony, as provided in  $\S 4-301(b)(2)$ , (6), (7), [and] (8), (9), AND (10) of this subtitle.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Insurance

2–102.

- (a) (1) The Commissioner shall establish divisions or sections in the Administration, along the following lines of responsibility:
  - (i) life insurance and health insurance;
  - (ii) property insurance and casualty insurance;
  - (iii) audit and examination;
  - (iv) insurance professions; [and]
  - (v) consumer affairs; AND
  - (VI) INSURANCE FRAUD.

2-104.

- (f) (1) The Commissioner may appoint [field] investigators, ACCOUNTANTS, AND STATISTICIANS.
- (2) As directed by the Commissioner, the [field] investigators shall investigate, in the State, violations or alleged violations of this article, INCLUDING § X-XXX OF THIS ARTICLE.
  - (g) (2) The Administration shall have:
    - (i) a principal counsel who is an assistant Attorney General; and
- (ii) other assistant Attorneys General, INCLUDING ASSISTANT ATTORNEYS GENERAL SPECIFICALLY ASSIGNED TO THE FRAUD DIVISION, as provided by the State budget.

- (a) The following persons are subject to taxation under this [title] SUBTITLE:
- (1) a person engaged as principal in the business of writing insurance contracts, surety contracts, guaranty contracts, or annuity contracts;
  - (2) an attorney in fact for a reciprocal insurer;
