SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1993. It shall remain effective for a period of [2] 5 years and, at the end of June 30, [1995] 1998, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Chapter 6 of the Acts of 1994

SECTION 17. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, at the end of June 30, [1995] 1997, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, § 21-315 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article, as enacted by Section 2 of this Act, shall be void, and § 21-315 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article as enacted by Section 3 of this Act shall take effect. This section supersedes the termination and abrogation provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 234 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1993.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT-FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act is contingent on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 17 of Chapter 6 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, as amended by Section 3 of this Act. If that termination provision takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be void.

SECTION 5. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 4 of this Act, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1995.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
