- (n) (1) The Sheriff of Harford County shall not have employment outside of that position, and shall receive a salary of:
  - (i) \$52,000 in 1991;
  - (ii) \$55,000 in 1992;
  - (iii) \$58,000 in 1993; and
  - (iv) \$60,000 in 1994 and thereafter.
- (2) [He] THE SHERIFF shall appoint the number of deputies at the compensation provided in the county budget.
  - [(2)](3) The Sheriff may appoint as a special deputy sheriff:
    - (i) The chief of police of a Harford County municipality; or
- (ii) A member of the police force of a Harford County municipality who is certified by the Maryland Police Training Commission.
- [(3)](4) A special deputy sheriff appointed under this subsection is not an employee of THE SHERIFF OR OF Harford County.
- (5) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE HARFORD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MAY NOT BE TERMINATED WITHOUT JUST CAUSE.
  - (II) SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO:
    - 1. THE CHIEF DEPUTY;
    - A LIEUTENANT COLONEL OR MAJOR:
    - THE SECRETARY FOR THE SHERIFF;
    - 4. A DEPUTY OR EMPLOYEE ON PROBATIONARY STATUS;

OR

CENTER.

- 5. THE WARDEN OF THE HARFORD COUNTY DETENTION
- (6) (I) A LIEUTENANT COLONEL OR MAJOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SHERIFF.
- (II) A LIEUTENANT COLONEL, MAJOR, OR CAPTAIN MAY NOT BE REDUCED BELOW THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT WITHOUT JUST CAUSE.
