(1) SHALL REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES;

(2) SHALL RECOMMEND THE APPOINTMENT BY THE BOARD OF QUALIFIED FACULTY MEMBERS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES NECESSARY FOR THE EFFICIENT ADMINISTRATION OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN BALTIMORE COUNTY;

(3) SHALL RECOMMEND THE DISCHARGE OF EMPLOYEES FOR GOOD CAUSE; HOWEVER, ANY EMPLOYEE WITH TENURE SHALL BE GIVEN REASONABLE NOTICE OF THE GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD;
