~~(C) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNING BODY MAY SUBMIT WRITTEN COMMENTS TO THE UNIT.~~

## CHAPTER 412

(House Bill 117)

AN ACT concerning

### Maryland Higher Education Commission – ~~Student Member~~ Membership

FOR the purpose of allowing the student member of the Maryland Higher Education Commission to vote on Commission business; altering the qualifications and selection of the student member of the Commission; specifying the term the student member of the Commission serves; allowing the student member to be a part-time student employee; allowing for the reappointment of the student member clarifying a certain quorum requirement; and generally relating to the ~~selection and service of the student member~~ membership of the Maryland Higher Education Commission.
