- (e) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the [Superintendent] SECRETARY to conduct a business to provide private detective services.
- (f) "Licensed private detective agency" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a person who is licensed by the [Superintendent] SECRETARY to conduct a business that provides private detective services.
- (m) ["Superintendent"] "SECRETARY" means the [Superintendent] SECRETARY of the [Maryland] State Police.
