CHAPTER 458

(House Bill 919)

AN ACT concerning

**Wicomico County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Restaurant Entrance and Egress)**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person in Wicomico County from entering or egressing a restaurant that holds a certain alcoholic beverages license while that person is in possession of alcoholic beverages; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Wicomico County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

6-201.

(x) (2) (iv) 3. This license requires the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption only on the inside of the restaurant premises. A PERSON MAY NOT ENTER OR EGRESS THE PREMISES WHILE IN POSSESSION OF ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
