- 1. MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY 12 NOON TO 9 P.M.; AND
 - 2. SUNDAY FROM 12:30 P.M. TO 10 P.M. 1 P.M. TO 5 P.M.
- (II) DURING BASEBALL GAMES ONLY, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT BE $SOLD_{\underline{:}}$
- 1. AFTER THE SEVENTH <u>BEGINNING</u> OF THE <u>EIGHTH</u> INNING; OR
- <u>2.</u> <u>DURING A DOUBLE HEADER GAME, AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE SIXTH INNING OF THE SECOND GAME.</u>

AN ACT concerning

Driver Education Programs - Elimination of State Funding
