ARRANGE FOR ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE. SHOULD THE RECIPIENT BE UNABLE TO SECURE ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE AFTER REASONABLE STEPS HAVE BEEN TAKEN, THE DEPARTMENT SHOULD MAKE EVERY REASONABLE EFFORT TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE.

- (III) THE RECIPIENT WITH A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 3-YEARS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT TRAINING AND WORK-REQUIREMENTS FOR MORE THAN 20 HOURS PROVIDED THAT THE RECIPIENT ARRANGES FOR ADEQUATE CHILD CARE.
- (IV) THE RECIPIENT WITH A CHILD OVER THE AGE OF 3 YEARS SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT TRAINING AND WORK REQUIREMENTS FOR UP TO 40 HOURS PER WEEK PROVIDED THAT THERE IS ADEQUATE CHILD CARE. THE RECIPIENT SHALL TAKE ALL REASONABLE STEPS TO ARRANGE FOR ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE. SHOULD THE RECIPIENT BE UNABLE TO SECURE ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE AFTER REASONABLE STEPS HAVE BEEN TAKEN, THE DEPARTMENT SHOULD MAKE EVERY REASONABLE EFFORT TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE AND NECESSARY CHILD CARE.
- (D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE RECIPIENT SHALL SIGN AN AGREEMENT WHICH SHALL:
- (I) REQUIRE—THE RECIPIENT TO COMPLY WITH REASONABLE REQUESTS FOR COOPERATION BY CASE MANAGEMENT WORKERS IN APPLYING FOR PROGRAMS OR RESOURCES THAT MAY BE AVAILABLE TO THE RECIPIENT: AND
- (II) REQUIRE—THE—DEPARTMENT—TO—PROVIDE—SUPPORTIVE SERVICES, INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION—AND CHILD CARE, NECESSARY—FOR THE RECIPIENT TO MEET THE RECIPIENT'S OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE PILOT.
- (2) (1) APPLICANTS FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE REFERRED TO A CASE WORKER-FOR A FAMILY ASSESSMENT.
  - (II) ALL APPLICANTS SHALL BE ASSESSED REGARDING:
    - 4. REASONS FOR APPLYING FOR ASSISTANCE:
    - 2. TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY FOR AFDC:
- 3. SUITABILITY FOR USE OF THE WELFARE AVOIDANCE GRANT, AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (N) OF THIS SECTION:
- 4. ANY MEDICALLY CERTIFIED DISABILITY THAT WOULD PRECLUDE PARTICIPATION IN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES: AND
- 5. ANY-OTHER NEED FOR SUPPORT-SERVICES NECESSARY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PILOT.
- (D) (1) (I) APPLICANTS FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER OR CURRENT RECIPIENTS ASSIGNED TO THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE REFERRED TO A CASE WORKER FOR A FAMILY ASSESSMENT.
