CHAPTER 494

(Senate Bill 250)

AN ACT concerning

Woodrow Wilson Bridge and Tunnel Compact

FOR the purpose of establishing, through the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and Tunnel Compact with the Commonwealth of Virginia ~~and the District of Columbia~~, the ~~National Capital Region~~ Woodrow Wilson Bridge and Tunnel Authority for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating a bridge, tunnel, or both a bridge and tunnel across the Potomac River; authorizing the Authority to exercise certain powers including the authority to issue revenue bonds and collect tolls; requiring the Governor to execute the Compact; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; requiring that certain studies be performed and reports thereon be provided to the Governor of the State of Maryland and the Maryland General
