15-207. OATHS AND SUBPOENAS.

(A) GENERALLY.

THE ETHICS COMMISSION AND STAFF COUNSEL EACH MAY:

- (1) ADMINISTER OATHS; AND
- (2) ISSUE SUBPOENAS FOR THE ATTENDANCE OF WITNESSES TO TESTIFY OR TO PRODUCE OTHER EVIDENCE.

(B) JUDICIAL ENFORCEMENT.

A SUBPOENA ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, MAY BE JUDICIALLY ENFORCED.
