- (2) IF THE RESPONDENT IS AN OFFICIAL, FOR EACH FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOUND TO HAVE BEEN FILED LATE, THE RESPONDENT SHALL PAY A FEE OF \$2 FOR EACH LATE DAY, NOT TO EXCEED A TOTAL OF \$250.

15-406. JUDICIAL REVIEW - ENFORCEMENT.

(A) JUDICIAL REVIEW.

IF THE RESPONDENT IS AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL ORDER OF THE ETHICS COMMISSION, THE RESPONDENT MAY SEEK JUDICIAL REVIEW AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE (ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT — CONTESTED CASES).

- (B) STAY PENDING JUDICIAL REVIEW.
- (1) THE ORDER IS STAYED AUTOMATICALLY UNTIL THE TIME FOR SEEKING JUDICIAL REVIEW HAS EXPIRED.
- (2) IF A TIMELY APPEAL IS FILED, THE ORDER IS STAYED UNTIL FINAL DISPOSITION BY THE COURT.
 - (C) JUDICIAL RELIEF FOR THE ETHICS COMMISSION.

THE ETHICS COMMISSION MAY SEEK JUDICIAL ENFORCEMENT AND OTHER RELIEF AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBTITLE 8 OF THIS TITLE.
