

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, OTHER THAN BY REASON OF DEATH, LEAVES AN OFFICE FOR WHICH A STATEMENT IS REQUIRED BY § 15-601(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL FILE THE STATEMENT WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER LEAVING THE OFFICE.

(B) PERIOD COVERED.

THE STATEMENT SHALL COVER:

(1) THE CALENDAR YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE YEAR IN WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL LEFT OFFICE, UNLESS A STATEMENT COVERING THAT YEAR HAS ALREADY BEEN FILED BY THE INDIVIDUAL; AND

(2) THE PORTION OF THE CURRENT CALENDAR YEAR DURING WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL HELD THE OFFICE.

(C) EXCEPTIONS.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE THE FILING OF A STATEMENT IF:

(1) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS LEFT OFFICE TO BECOME AN OFFICIAL IN ANOTHER OFFICE FOR WHICH A STATEMENT IS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) THE DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE NEW OFFICE ARE AT LEAST AS EXTENSIVE AS THOSE OF THE OLD OFFICE.

15-605. SAME — CANDIDATES FOR OFFICE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A CANDIDATE WHO IS REQUIRED BY § 15-601(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE TO FILE A STATEMENT SHALL FILE THE STATEMENT EACH YEAR BEGINNING WITH THE YEAR IN WHICH THE CANDIDATE FILES A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY THROUGH THE YEAR OF THE ELECTION.

(B) EXCEPTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE THE FILING OF A STATEMENT FOR ANY FULL YEAR COVERED BY A STATEMENT FILED BY THE INDIVIDUAL UNDER § 15-602 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) FILING REQUIREMENTS.

A STATEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE FILED WITH THE ELECTION BOARD WITH WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY IS REQUIRED TO BE FILED.
