(a) If a police officer receives reliable information that a vehicle has been stolen, the police officer shall immediately report the theft to the Administration and the DEPARTMENT OF [Maryland] State Police, unless the police officer has received reliable information of the recovery of the vehicle.

(b) If a police officer receives reliable information that a vehicle which he previously reported stolen has been recovered, he shall immediately report the recovery to the Administration and the DEPARTMENT OF [Maryland] State Police.

(e) (1) The tests to determine alcohol concentration may be administered by an individual who has been examined and is certified by the DEPARTMENT OF [Maryland] State Police as sufficiently equipped and trained to administer the tests.

(2) The DEPARTMENT OF [Maryland] State Police may adopt regulations for the examination and certification of individuals trained to administer tests to determine alcohol concentration.
