SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Personnel shall adopt new regulations by November 1, 1995, to comply with the changes enacted to Subtitle 6 of Title 7 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article by Chapter 616 of the Acts of 1993, Chapter 471 of the Acts of 1994, and by this Act.
