

(3) SHALL CHOOSE A LOCATION IN THE COUNTY FOR THIS FESTIVAL WHICH IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE; AND

(4) SHALL ASSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE FESTIVAL IS THE PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER AND WINE.

(H) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 2-301(F) AND 12-103(C) OF THIS ARTICLE, BEER AND WINE PRODUCTS NOT AUTHORIZED FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION IN MARYLAND AT THE TIME OF THE FESTIVAL MAY BE SHIPPED DIRECTLY TO THE LICENSEE BY A LICENSED NONRESIDENT DEALER.

(2) ALL INVOICES FOR PRODUCTS DELIVERED DIRECTLY TO THE FESTIVAL BY A NONRESIDENT DEALER, OR CREDITS FOR AUTHORIZED RETURNS, SHALL BE MADE THROUGH A LICENSED MARYLAND WHOLESALER.

(3) BEER OR WINE DELIVERED DIRECTLY TO A SPECIAL BEER AND WINE FESTIVAL LICENSEE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE RETURNED DIRECTLY TO THE NONRESIDENT DEALER.

(4) WHENEVER A FESTIVAL LICENSE IS ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION, HOLDERS OF WHOLESALE LICENSES OR NONRESIDENT DEALER PERMITS MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HOLDER OF A FESTIVAL LICENSE TO DELIVER BEER AND WINE 2 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND TO ACCEPT RETURNS 2 DAYS AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE FESTIVAL LICENSE.

(I) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS SECTION.

8-309. 8-310.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "BOARD" MEANS THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

(3) "FESTIVAL" MEANS THE WORCESTER COUNTY BEER AND WINE FESTIVAL (WBWF).

(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WORCESTER COUNTY.

(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL FESTIVAL ~~WBWF~~ LICENSE.

(D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSE SHALL BE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING STATE RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, STATE CLASS 3 WINERY LICENSE, OR STATE CLASS 4 WINERY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

(E) A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSEE SHALL:
