~~(III) THE FEE FEES ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE SUFFICIENT TO PAY FOR THE COSTS OF ADMINISTERING THIS SUBSECTION, INCLUDING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF EACH MEMBER OF THE CASINO NIGHT COMMISSION UNDER PARAGRAPH (5)(II)9B OF THIS SUBSECTION.~~

~~(5) (4) (1) The [governing body of Prince George's] County may SHALL restrict, regulate, or prohibit the issuance of written permits authorized under this section, INCLUDING A PERMIT FOR A CASINO NIGHT ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.~~

~~(II) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH A CASINO NIGHT COMMISSION TO RECOMMEND REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF CASINO NIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RECEIPT OF GRATUITIES BY INDIVIDUALS WHO ASSIST IN THE CASINO NIGHT.~~

~~(III) 1: THE CASINO NIGHT COMMISSION CONSISTS OF NINE MEMBERS.~~
