A licensee whose average handle is ~~[\$300,000]~~ \$600,000 or less shall:

- (1) allocate 0.50% of each mutuel pool to the Commission as State tax;
- (2) subject to § 11-618 of this subtitle, allocate 0.25% of each mutuel pool to the Maryland Harness Track Employees Pension Fund;
- (3) keep 18.00% of each regular mutuel pool;
- (4) keep 20.00% of each multiple mutuel pool on 2 horses; and
- (5) keep 26.00% of each multiple mutuel pool on 3 or more horses.

11-617.

(a) From a licensee's share of the takeout on each mutuel pool, the licensee whose average handle is ~~[\$300,000]~~ \$600,000 or less shall allocate 1.75% to increased purses.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.

CHAPTER 591

(House Bill 1198)

AN ACT concerning

Ethics Law - Members of the General Assembly - Representation Before State Agencies

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a legislator from representing a person for compensation before a State agency in any matter involving procurement or the adoption ~~or implementation~~ of regulations; exempting representation in administrative proceedings conducted in accordance with the contested case provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act; and generally relating to the regulation of transactions by members of the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
