- (2) PROVIDE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR-MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST.
- (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BE AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE COUNSELING UNDER SUPERVISION AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IF:
- (1) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE IN A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING FIELD FROM AN ACCREDITED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION THAT IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD:
- (2) IN THE-CASE-OF-AN INDIVIDUAL HOLDING-ONLY A MASTER'S DEGREE, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS COMPLETED, EITHER AS A PART OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S MASTER'S DEGREE-PROGRAM OR AFTER THE AWARD OF THE MASTER'S DEGREE, A MINIMUM OF 60 GRADUATE CREDIT HOURS IN COUNSELING TRAINING APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND
- (3) IN THE CASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL HOLDING A DOCTORAL DEGREE, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS COMPLETED, EITHER AS A PART OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S DOCTORAL PROGRAM OR AFTER THE AWARD OF THE DOCTORAL DEGREE, A MINIMUM OF 90 GRADUATE CREDIT HOURS IN COUNSELOR TRAINING AS DESCRIBED IN § 17-302(D) OF THIS SUBTITLE AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD.
- (C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY BE AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY UNDER SUPERVISION AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE IN A MARRIAGE AND FAMILY FIELD OR HAS COMPLETED A PROGRAM OF STUDIES JUDGED BY THE BOARD TO BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT IN SUBJECT MATTER AND EXTENT OF TRAINING AS REQUIRED UNDER § 17–302(D) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (A) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT:
- (I) REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC BY TITLE, BY DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, METHODS, OR PROCEDURES, OR OTHERWISE, THAT THE PERSON IS A COUNSELOR:
- (II) USE ANY TITLE, ABBREVIATION, SIGN, CARD, OR OTHER REPRESENTATION THAT THE PERSON IS A COUNSELOR;
- (III) USE ANY TITLE, ABBREVIATION, SIGN, CARD, OR OTHER REPRESENTATION THAT INCLUDES THE WORD COUNSELOR; OR
- (IV) USE THE TITLE COUNSELOR OR A TITLE THAT CONTAINS THE WORD—COUNSELOR—WITH—THE INTENT TO REPRESENT THAT THE PERSON PRACTICES COUNSELING.
