

AS IT RELATES TO THE BOARD OF MUNICIPAL AND ZONING APPEALS, the changes under Section 1 of this Act may not be given effect until Article VII[, § 89] of the Charter is amended in accordance with Article XI-A of the Constitution of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Agriculture

11-204.

(d) The Secretary shall conduct inspections as provided in a memorandum of understanding on behalf of and in coordination with other agencies when performing weights and measures inspections at gasoline retailing operations.

Article – Business Regulation

10-203.

(a) The Comptroller periodically shall collect or cause to be collected and cause to be analyzed samples of all motor fuel that is:

- (1) subject to regulation under this title; and
- (2) stored and offered for sale in the State.

(b) The Comptroller shall conduct inspections as provided in a memorandum of understanding on behalf of and in coordination with other agencies when collecting motor fuel samples under this section.

Article – Environment

The Department shall conduct inspections as provided in a memorandum of understanding on behalf of and in coordination with other agencies when administering the inspection of gasoline retailing operations under this subtitle.
