CHAPTER 607

(Senate Bill 228)

AN ACT concerning

Social Services – Statewide Nutrition Assistance Program

FOR the purpose of establishing a Statewide Nutrition Assistance Program; establishing a grant program to provide funding for certain food distribution organizations; establishing certain responsibilities of the Department of Human Resources for administering the Program; requiring a certain report; defining certain terms; and generally relating to establishing a Statewide Nutrition Assistance Program.

Article 88A – Social Services Administration

Section 130A through 130E, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle “Statewide Nutrition Assistance Program”
