SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

(a) The provisions of this section apply in the following counties:

- (9) Garrett County;
- (10) Howard County;

- (12) St. Mary's County;
- (13) Somerset County;
- (14) Talbot County; and
- (15) Washington County.

(b) (1) This subtitle may not be construed to make it unlawful for any volunteer fire company or bona fide fraternal, civic, war veterans', religious or charitable organization or corporation to conduct or hold a carnival, bazaar, or raffle for the
