- (4) $(\underline{6})$ The Terms of Members of the Commission are Staggered as required by the Terms in Effect for Members of the Commission on October JULY 1, 1995.
- (5) (7) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
- (6) (8) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
 - (7) (9) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:
 - (I) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (II) MAY BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH A POLICY OF THE BOARD.
- (D) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL <u>ANNUALLY</u> CHOOSE A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.
