- (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE SHALL EXERCISE DUE CARE TO AVOID COLLIDING WITH ANY BICYCLE BEING RIDDEN BY A PERSON.
- [(a)](B) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person riding a bicycle.
- [(b)](C) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike, injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle.
