- (i) 6 shall be representatives of amateur and professional sports in the State;
  - (ii) 3 shall be representatives of State and local government;
  - (iii) 4 shall be representatives of the general public;
- (iv) 2 shall be members of the House of Delegates, selected by the Speaker of the House; and
- (v) 2 shall be members of the Senate of Maryland, selected by the President of the Senate.
  - (b) (1) The term of a member is 3 years.
- (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms of the members of the Commission on July 1, 1988.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (c) (1) The Commission may appoint, from within or without its members, such subcommittees as the Commission deems appropriate to carry out the Commission's duties under this subtitle.
- (2) The subcommittee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission.

## [4-404.] 4-504.

From among its members, the Governor shall designate a chairman and a vice chairman.

## [4-405.] 4-505.

- (a) The Commission shall meet at the times and places that it determines.
- (b) A member of the Commission or a subcommittee of the Commission:
  - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (c) The Department shall provide a staff to the Commission as needed. [4-406.] 4-506.

## The Commission shall:

(1) Investigate and collect information that relates to the economic, fiscal, and social effects of amateur and professional sports franchises in the State;
