- (2) <u>BEFORE REMOVING A MEMBER, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL</u> <u>SEND THE MEMBER A COPY OF THE CHARGES AGAINST THE MEMBER AND GIVE THE</u> <u>MEMBER AN OPPORTUNITY WITHIN 10 DAYS TO REQUEST A HEARING.</u>
 - (3) IF THE MEMBER REQUESTS A HEARING WITHIN THE 10-DAY PERIOD:
- (I) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT PROMPTLY SHALL HOLD A
 HEARING, BUT THE HEARING MAY NOT BE SET WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE STATE
 SUPERINTENDENT SENDS THE MEMBER A NOTICE OF THE HEARING; AND
- (II) THE MEMBER SHALL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD PUBLICLY BEFORE THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT IN THE MEMBER'S OWN DEFENSE, IN PERSON, OR BY COUNSEL.
- (4) A MEMBER REMOVED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION HAS THE RIGHT TO A
 DE NOVO REVIEW OF THE REMOVAL BY THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR CALVERT COUNTY.
- (J) AT ITS FIRST MEETING AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL ELECT A PRESIDENT AND A VICE-PRESIDENT FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.
- (K) THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE \$3,000 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION AND THE OTHER MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE \$2,000 EACH ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION.
 - (L) (1) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH.
- (2) EXCEPT FOR THOSE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING AND A RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS SHALL BE MADE PUBLIC.
- (3) THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTIONS IN CLOSED SESSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-508 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- (M) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD WHO TAKE OFFICE ON JANUARY 1, 1997 SHALL EXPIRE AS FOLLOWS:
 - (1) TWO MEMBERS IN 2001;
 - (2) TWO MEMBERS IN 2002; AND
 - (3) ONE MEMBER IN 2003.
