- (b) The Trust shall consist of the following advisor nonvoting members:
 - (1) the Director of the Baltimore Museum of Art:
 - (2) the Director of the Maryland Historical Society;
 - (3) the Director of the St. Mary's City Commission;
 - (4) the Director of the Talbot County Historical Society;
 - (5) the Director of the Walters Museum of Art;
 - (6) the Director of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts;
