SUBTITLE 4. PROCUREMENT BY LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.

A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN A COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY SHALL CONDUCT ALL PROCUREMENT, AS DEFINED UNDER § 11–101 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, EITHER THROUGH:
