Charter Amendment Resolution 94-1 - Redistricting

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN ON NORTH BRENTWOOD, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 13A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957) Edition as amended, to amend the charter of said Town, said charter being Article 17 of the Code of Public Legal Laws of Maryland (1963) Edition, as amended, which contains in whole or par [in part] the Charter of the Town of North Brentwood, be repealing and re-enacting with amendments Section 56-3. Wards.

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 711 OF THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF NORTH EAST TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF INTEREST ON TAX PAYMENTS IN ARREARS; FOR ESTABLISHING A TAX PENALTY ON OVERDUE REAL ESTATE TAXES EQUAL TO THE COUNTY'S COLLECTION FEE AND LOST INTEREST TO THE TOWN; AND, TO ESTABLISH THE DATE WHEN REAL ESTATE TAXES BECOME COLLECTABLE BY TAX SALE.
