FOR the purpose of eliminating the filling of land with combustion ash as a conditional use in all industrial districts and making it a use permitted by special exception; adding criteria related to buffers, amount of fill permitted, access, traffic and roads, grading, stormwater management, hours of operation, archeological preservation, cover material, and monitoring of ground and surface water; defining certain terms; making a technical correction; and generally relating to the filling of land with combustion ash
