AN ORDINANCE concerning:

Agricultural Preservation Program

FOR the purpose of establishing certain conditions under which a landowner may request that an agricultural easement be purchased; providing for the purchase of agricultural easements over a certain number of years; providing for the purchase of agricultural easements with certain revenues; limiting the conveyances which may be made in a family conveyance subdivision that is subject to an agricultural easement; and generally relating to the Agricultural Preservation Program.

FOR the purpose of requiring transfers of pension plan assets to accompany transfers of employees from ~~certain other one County pension plans plan to the Retirement Plan for Appointed and Elected Officials~~ another; specifying the method for calculating the amount of assets to be transferred; providing for the retroactive applicability of the provisions of this Ordinance; requiring certain actions by the Personnel Officer; and generally relating to ~~the Retirement Plan for Appointed and Elected Officials~~ transfers between County retirement plans.
