AN ORDINANCE concerning

**Massage Establishments - Licensure and Operation**

FOR the purpose of requiring ~~a license~~ certain licenses for the ownership or operation of certain massage establishments and the administration of massages for monetary consideration; establishing procedures for the grant, denial, suspension, and revocation of licenses; establishing requirements for the operation of massage establishments; prohibiting certain acts; providing for enforcement; establishing penalties; and generally relating to the licensing and operation of massage establishments and massage technicians.
