Bill No. 6-1994

An Act amending the Adequate Public Facilities Act to allow exemptions for certain minor subdivisions and resubdivisions.

[Amending Section 16.1107(b)(1) of the Howard County Code.

Effective Date April 11, 1994]

Bill No. 7-1994

An Act regulating massage establishments and their staff.

[Adding Sections 14.800 through 14.816 to the Howard County Code.

Effective Date April 11, 1994]

Bill No. 10-1994

An Act pursuant to Section 403 "Reorganization of the Executive Branch" of the Howard County Charter, transferring the responsibility for issuance and renewal of animal licenses from the Police Department to the Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits; declaring the provisions of this Act to be effective July 1, 1994.

[Amending Sections 17.200A(d)(3), 17.300, 17.301, and 17.308 of the Howard County Code.]

Bill No. 11-1994

An Act pursuant to Section 403 "Reorganization of the Executive Branch" of the Howard County Code, moving the vehicle and small engines function to the Department of General Services and otherwise clarifying the duties of the Department of General Services; declaring the provisions of this Act effective July 1, 1994.

[Amending Sections 25.101(c) and 6.200(d)(1) of the Howard County Code.

Repealing Sections 6.201(d), 6.211(b), and 18.1001(c)(7) of the Howard County Code.]

Bill No. 12-1994

An Act amending the size of the signs to be placed on private property by property owners to notify the public of parking restrictions which, if violated, will result in the towing of the unauthorized vehicle.

[Amending Section 17.603(b) of the Howard County Code.
