(3) A youth apprenticeship program approved by the Secretary of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE that involves clients of the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.

 - (5) to an individual with whom the child is placed in foster care by:
- (i) a child placement agency that is licensed under § 5-507 of this subtitle;
 - (ii) a local department;
 - (iii) the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE;

 - (v) a court of competent jurisdiction;

- (b) This section does not apply:

- (d) (2) "Employee" does not include any person employed to work for compensation by the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.
