

(3) A youth apprenticeship program approved by the Secretary of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE that involves clients of the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.

**Article - Family Law**

5-508.

(b) This section does not apply:

(5) to an individual with whom the child is placed in foster care by:

(i) a child placement agency that is licensed under § 5-507 of this subtitle;

(ii) a local department;

(iii) the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE;

(iv) the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene; or

(v) a court of competent jurisdiction;

5-509.

(b) This section does not apply:

(3) to an institution that accepts only children placed by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.

(c) The Department shall pay for foster care for a child who needs the most demanding special care in a single family home at a monthly rate that is not less than the higher of:

(1) the rate that the Department paid in fiscal year 1975; and

(2) the rate that the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE pays for the current fiscal year.

(d) (2) "Employee" does not include any person employed to work for compensation by the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.

(c) (2) The advisory council shall consist of the following members:

(i) 1 person from the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE, to be designated by the Secretary of the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE;

(ii) 1 person from the Maryland State Department of Education, to be designated by the State Superintendent of Schools;
