

(4) Two representatives from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Department of Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE, or the Department of Education, nominated by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;

(5) One representative of a Baltimore City community group;

(6) One representative of an AIDS advocacy group;

(7) One drug abuse treatment counselor;

(8) One recovering injecting drug user; and

(9) Up to three other individuals whom the Mayor of Baltimore City determines to be appropriate for appointment to the oversight committee.

**Article - State Government**

8-201.

(b) The principal departments of the Executive Branch of the State government are:

(1) Agriculture;

(2) Budget and Fiscal Planning;

(3) Economic and Employment Development;

(4) The Environment;

(5) General Services;

(6) Health and Mental Hygiene;

(7) Housing and Community Development;

(8) Human Resources;

(9) Licensing and Regulation;

(10) Natural Resources;

(11) Personnel;

(12) Public Safety and Correctional Services;

(13) Transportation; and

(14) Juvenile [Services] JUSTICE.

(1) 1 shall be a member of the State Senate;
