(a) At any time when the office of Chief Boiler Inspector or deputy boiler inspector shall become vacant, the Secretary of Personnel shall, as soon as practicable, conduct a competitive examination in accordance with Title 4 of the State Personnel AND PENSIONS Article, the examination to be the same or equivalent to the examination given by the Board of Boiler Rules for special inspectors in § 174 of this subtitle. The Commissioner of Labor and Industry with the approval of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation shall appoint from the successful candidates a Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector, as the case may be.
