

assessment, enclosure, removal, repair, renovation, or demolition of asbestos material IN A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING OR in a school building; [or]

(ii) The inspection, planning, or design of any project IN A SCHOOL BUILDING as enumerated in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph; OR

(III) THE INSPECTION OR DESIGN OF ANY PROJECT IN A PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING AS ENUMERATED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

(2) "Asbestos occupation" does not include work on any small-scale, short-duration operations, maintenance, and repair activities as defined in 40 CFR 763, APPENDIX C TO SUBPART E, [asbestos-containing materials in schools] ASBESTOS MODEL ACCREDITATION PLAN.

[(d)](C) "Asbestos material" means any material or product which contains more than 1 percent asbestos.

[(e)](D) "Business entity" means a partnership, firm, association, corporation, sole proprietorship, or other business concern.

(E) "INTERIOR SPACE" INCLUDES:

- (1) EXTERIOR HALLWAYS CONNECTING BUILDINGS;
- (2) PORTICOES; AND
- (3) MECHANICAL SYSTEMS USED TO CONDITION INTERIOR SPACE.

(f) "License" means a license issued by the Department under this subtitle to remove and encapsulate asbestos.

(G) (1) "PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING" MEANS THE INTERIOR SPACE OF ANY BUILDING THAT IS NOT A SCHOOL BUILDING.

(2) "PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING" INCLUDES:

- (I) INDUSTRIAL AND OFFICE BUILDINGS;
- (II) RESIDENTIAL APARTMENT BUILDINGS OF 10 OR MORE DWELLING UNITS;
- (III) CONDOMINIUMS OF 10 OR MORE DWELLING UNITS;
- (IV) GOVERNMENT-OWNED BUILDINGS;
- (V) COLLEGES;
- (VI) MUSEUMS;
- (VII) AIRPORTS;
- (VIII) HOSPITALS;
- (IX) CHURCHES;
