Article 20 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 2-408 of Article 20 – Somerset County of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 2-409.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 20 – Somerset County**

2-408.

(A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY SELL THE PROPERTY AT COUNTY TAX MAP REFERENCE 64-23-554 (KNOWN AS CARVEL HALL) TO ANY PERSON AT PRIVATE SALE UNDER ANY TERMS THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.

(B) THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 25, § 11A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND DO NOT APPLY TO A SALE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.

**CHAPTER 45**

**(House Bill 209)**

AN ACT concerning

**Somerset County – Private Sale of Property — *Adjacent to Princess Anne Industrial Park Land***

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to sell certain property ~~known as~~ *adjacent to* Princess Anne Industrial Park Land at private sale for certain purposes to any person under any terms; exempting a certain sale of property from certain requirements; and generally relating to the sale of specified property by the County Commissioners of Somerset County.
