SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article 20 – Somerset County**

2-408.

- (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY SELL THE APPROXIMATELY 14.5 ACRES OF PROPERTY AT COUNTY TAX MAP REFERENCE 16–13–222 (ADIACENT TO THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS PRINCESS ANNE INDUSTRIAL PARK LAND) TO ANY PERSON AT PRIVATE SALE FOR THE PURPOSES OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OR COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE UNDER ANY TERMS THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.
- (B) THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 25, § 11A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND DO NOT APPLY TO A SALE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
