

(b) The [commissioners] COUNTY COMMISSIONERS by resolution may establish procedures for the administrative transfer of appropriations between general classifications of expenditures in the current expense budget within the same office or department, TRANSFERS BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES, BOARDS, OR COMMISSIONS, interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects in the capital budget, and the addition of new budget items. [However, only changes involving less than \$5,000 each may be made under this subsection.

(c) Transfers or additions involving an amount of \$5,000 or more, or transfers between departments, agencies, boards, or commissions may be made only by resolution approved by the commissioners.

(d)] (C) Any change involving funds totaling more than \$50,000 may be made only by resolution approved by the commissioners after compliance with the publication and hearing requirements applicable to the original proposed budget.

[(e)](D) To meet a public emergency affecting life, health, or property, the commissioners by resolution may make emergency appropriations from contingent or surplus funds.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
