SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Insurance

1-101.

(e) (1) “Annuity” means an agreement to make periodic payments for which the making or continuance of all or some of a series of the [payment,] PAYMENTS, or the amount of a payment, depends on the continuance of a human life.
