(House Bill 584)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County – Fire and Rescue Workers – Length of Service Award Program – Benefit Adjustments

FOR the purpose of repealing the cap on the maximum overall increase in adjustments to benefits under the length of service award program for qualified active volunteer members of the Charles County Volunteer Fire Companies, Volunteer Rescue Squads and mobile intensive care units; requiring any benefit adjustment under the program to be applied only prospectively; and generally relating to benefit adjustments in the Length of Service Award Program for certain fire and rescue workers in Charles County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 9 – Charles County

54–8.

There is hereby established a length of service award program for qualified active volunteer members of the Charles County Volunteer Fire Companies; Volunteer Rescue Squads and mobile intensive care units. For the purposes of §§ 54–8 through 54–11, “active volunteer member” means a person who accumulated a minimum of fifty (50) points per calendar year in accordance with the point system set forth in Section 54–11.
