

CHAPTER 74

(House Bill 1015)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County Board of Education – Appeals

PG 403-96

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Prince George's County Board of Education or a designated committee of the County Board of Education to hear appeals of certain matters relating to certain students; making a certain exception; requiring that a committee designated to hear certain appeals shall consist of at least a certain number of members and that a quorum of the committee consist of a certain number of members; and generally relating to the authority of the Prince George's County Board of Education to hear appeals of certain matters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

3-806.

(A) IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS OTHERWISE GRANTED TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN THIS ARTICLE, THE COUNTY BOARD OR A DESIGNATED COMMITTEE OF THE COUNTY BOARD MAY HEAR AN APPEAL FROM A DECISION OF THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT THAT RELATES TO THE GRADE, TRANSFER, TUITION, OR ANY ASPECT OF PARTICIPATION IN A PROGRAM OR ACTIVITY OF A SPECIFIC STUDENT WHO IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 8, SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(B) A DESIGNATED COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST 5 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AND AT LEAST 5 MEMBERS OF A DESIGNATED COMMITTEE SHALL BE PRESENT TO CONSTITUTE A QUORUM OF THE COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
